The River Nene Regional Park is a community interest company that delivers environmental outcomes in the Nene Valley. The organisation is creating a resource plan for the program that includes formal funding opportunities and engaging local businesses in supporting delivery. Additionally, through the catchment sensitive farming program, the company is working with rural land holders in the catchment to reduce environmental impact and improve productivity.

The Welland Rivers Trust was involved in the initial stages of the project, introducing project members to design principles and outcomes of an urban river restoration project, based upon a large scale pilot restoration project at Market Harborough. The organisation has also been involved with attracting volunteers.

Masters students at **Cranfield University** were involved in a variety of group projects which gave them the opportunity to work on real-world environmental issues. One of these groups looked into water quality issues; carrying out risk assessment work, drafting community engagement resources and developing recommendations for monitoring the water quality in the area.

RiverCare – a collaboration between Anglian Water and Keep Britain Tidy – is piloting a new monitoring survey to assess whether the improvement works have made a real difference to the health of the river.

Anglian Water is helping to reduce pollution entering the brooks through their asset management programme.
